INSTITUTE'S RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The General rules and regulations of Gauhati University and Assam Higher Secondary Education Council will be followed.
- The institute is a co-educational institution where all forms of Differently Abled students could be admitted.
- 3. Institute hour in general will be from 10.30 a.m to 3.30 pm. (10.30-1.00 pm theory classes 1.00-1.30 pm leisure 1.30-3.00 Computer Practical)
- 4. The institute lays great emphasis on discipline and character building of the students. A student if found guilty of disobeying the institute rules, strict disciplinary actions which includes expelling from the institute/rusticated for a period/ debarred from appearing in any examination for one or more years etc. will be taken against him/her which will be decided by the disciplinary committee headed by the director and his decision shall be final in all such matter.
- 5. All forms of ragging in the institute campus are strictly prohibited. Anyone found indulging in ragging will be firmly dealt with disciplinary action.
- 6. Any violation of rules, unsatisfactory progress, irregular attendance, non-clearance of institute dues, discourtesy to faculty members in any forms, adoption of unfair means during examination will be dealt strictly.
- 7. Any notice desired to be circulated to students in the institute campus will require the prior approval of the authority of the institute.
- 8. Mobile phone in the classroom is strictly prohibited.

EXAMINATION RULES:

The institute examination branch conduct all the institute examinations. All students must appear in all examinations conducted by the institute during one academic year and attend their classes regularly-the minimum must be 75% of the classes held.

ATTENDANCE:

75% attendance in classes is compulsory. A student who fails to attend 75% of the classes will be dis-collegiated. The name of the student failing to attend classes for 15 consecutive days without any information shall be struck off the roles without notice.

IDENTITY CARDS:

A non-transferable Identity card will be issued to every student during the time of admission against payment of Rs.100.00. The students are required to keep the Identity cards with them during institute hours and to be produced whenever demanded for. Identity cards are issued only annually. Issuing the duplicate id cards will be charged 200 Rs.

GUARDIAN PARTICIPATION:

All guardians should keep contact with the Director from time to time to keep track of the academic progress of their wards. Constructive suggestions from the guardians are most welcome at any time.

UNIFORM:

Institute uniform is compulsory for all students. Students are directed to maintain decency in their attire. Students are directed to come to the institute with prescribed Institute uniform otherwise they will not be allowed to enter the Institute premises.

DRESS CODE-

Black pant with purple and white sporting (summer)Black Blazer (winter)

ADMISSION RULES:

A Candidate will have to submit photocopy of Mark sheet of the qualifying examination duly attested by Gov. Gazetted officer along with the application form.

- 1. A candidate must produce the following documents at the time of admission.
 - A. Original Mark sheet, admit card of the last qualifying examination.
 - **B.** Five copies of recent passport size photographs.
 - C. The original certificate from the head of institution last attended.
 - **D.** Original caste certificate from the concerned authority.
 - E. Students from other board outside Assam shall have to produce Migration certificate (where necessary)
 - **F.** Fees ones paid are not refundable. If a document submitted by a candidate found to be forged will be liable for the cancellation of the admission.
 - G. Students with gap in academic will have to submit a gap certificate from any one of the following-
 - A. The Head of the Institutions last attended.
 - B. Govt. Gazette Officer.
 - C. Medical Officer.
 - **D.** Officer-in-charge of the nearest police station.
 - H. Registration forms must be submitted within 10 days of the admission.
 - I. The tuition fees cover twelve calendar months. A student leaving the Institute in mid-session shall have to pay tuition fees for the whole year.
 - J. Disability certificate from the competent authority is must at the time of admission into any programme.

RESERVATION:

- Reservation under the rules of Govt of India will be followed by PIPWD.
- Two seats are reserved for the students securing 80% or above marks in HS Final Exam for free admission.
- 1 Lakh Rupees will be awarded to the best performer with disability in every 3
 years.
- Admission is 50% free for the 2 students who has BPL card. (Final selection is made by college authority).

ADMISSION FEE STRUCTURE: LIMITED SEATS:

BDE admission fee: Rs. 22,000/-(3 years)

Monthly tuition fees: Rs 1000/-

TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES:

- If students pay installment Rs 25,000/- at the time of admission than they have to pay Rs 1000/- per month only. or
- If students pay installment Rs 10,000/- at the time of admission. Or
- Student have to pay Rs 100/- per day
